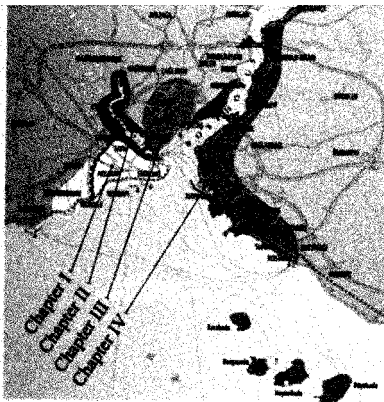

The first churches were built in basilical plan. We see that central planned, vaulted, and narthexed churches were constructed in the course of time and later we see the construction of the Greek cross-planned churches.
